




The Principal is the head of institution; responsible for the day to day affairs and administration of the College in accordance with the rules and directives approved by the Board of Governors. Provision of financial assistance is through Government of Balochistan as Grant-in-Aid.







Maintenance of high standard of discipline is the hall mark of Cadet College as it lays a very significant role in grooming and molding the Cadet's personality to be the Future Leaders of Tomorrow.

Annual Calendar 😉

Encompasses the years scheduled academic, curricular and extra-curricular events including, term breaks and vacation. Annual Calendar is issued at the start of year's academic session with prior approval of the principal.

Daily Routine

While in the college, cadets have to follow the daily routine. The Purpose of daily routine is to make a balance time distribution for each activity. This is mandatory not only for their academic but also for physical growth.

Prayers

All prayers are compulsory for Cadets.

Absence From College (2)

The name of cadet will be struck off from College Roll after six days of an unauthorized absence, without any further notice.

Parents Visiting Days (

Parents and guests (names given at the time of admission are only allowed to meet/visit the Cadets on Sundays (Parents' Visiting Days) however, in case of emergency Parents only are allowed with prior approval of Principal.









Extra Money



Cadets are not allowed to keep cash more than Rs. 500; if found, the • Absence from the college without proper leave. amount will be confiscated and will not be refunded. However, • If a Cadet fails twice in examination during his stay in the College. Parents may deposit extra money with the concerned House Master,

If a Cadet refuses to pay college Fees/ Dues. who shall keep record of such money. Cadets may get the money from the House Master once a week as per requirement.

Rules and Regulations (2)



Restrictions

Cadets found involved/ guilty are liable to be suspended or would be charged of fine form Rs. 5000 - 40,000/- for each category of offence. However, frequent repetition of in-disciplined activities may lead to withdrawal from the College. Following are strictly restricted:-

- Disfiguring or defacing College property.
- Lending or borrowing money.
- Keeping unauthorized medicines.
- Cheating in exams.
- Involved in sodomy/ homosexuality.
- Betting, gambling and lotteries etc.
- Stealing and indulgence of immoral conduct.
- Misbehaving with staff.
- Violation of College rules.
- Constantly poor performance in academics.
- Absence from the class/ activities without proper excuse.
- Smoking or using drugs or intoxicants.

- Visiting Café/ Canteen/ Barber Shop during unauth timings.
- Found in prohibited areas outside the College boundary.
- any junior/ senior or with batchmate. Quarreling with
- Keeping cash (more than Rs. 500) and valuable items with him.
- The parents/ guardians are liable to deposit the college fee in future within due date at two equal installments otherwise his son/ ward will be expelled from the college.
- The College authority has the right to impose a fine against the late comers after vacation; Rs. 1000/- to 5000/-.
- The College Discipline Committee is entitled to recommend fines for certain breaches of discipline if it deems it necessary.

Forbidden

In addition to above, following are strictly forbidden in College premises; any Cadet found keeping any of the following items will be fined Rs. 40,000

- Mobile Phone.
- Cigarettes/ E- Cigarettes.
- Radio/ Tape recorder/Video games/Cards
- Electric heater.
- Cassettes and any musical instrument.







UNIFORM

Cadets are not allowed to wear private clothes unless asked for special occasions. All Cadets have to be in prescribed uniform in the College premises. The detail of the uniform is as under.

APPOINTMENT HOLDERS

Appointments; a distinctive award given to best Cadets of 2nd Year Class. For the first time in *SAIFIAN* history, re-naming of appointment titles and nomination of four Cadets each at College and House level was under taken. At College, there is College Prefect and College Sports Secretary. In each House, there is House Prefect, Assistant House Prefect, Mess Secretary and Sports Secretary.

HOUSE SYSTEM

Cadet College Killa Saifullah is a residential/ boarding institution. For maintaining spirit-de-core, cohesion and grooming, Cadets are allotted Houses at the time of .Admission. There are four Houses namely Jinnah House, Iqbal House, Nashter House and Abdali House. These Houses are headed/ supervised by a House Master (HM), assisted by Assistant House Master (AHM) and House Officers. The House Staff is responsible for compliance of Daily Routine and day to day affairs regarding Cadets.

CADETS' MESS

Cadets College Killa Saifullah has a fully equipped Cadets' Mess with trained and experienced staff. Provision of nutritious and quality food to the Cadets is ensured. The Mess is under the supervision of Mess Committee headed by a senior faculty member (Chairman Mess Committee) assisted by Messing Officer. Other staff includes Caterer, Storekeeper, Cooks, Bearers, Dish Washer and Helpers.

LABORATORIES

Cadet College Killa Saifullah is equipped with modern and outfitted Science Laboratories for each genre including Biology, Chemistry, and Physics. Computer Labs is fully functional however, Audio-Visual (Language) is being made functional; Cadets get benefit of the modern technology available as being part of their syllabi.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

A Library is an important source of knowledge to young minds. It develops the important habit of reading amongst the students and impact positively on the academic achievement of Cadets as they can perform better during examination by reading various books. Cadet College Killa Saifullah has a Library equipped with huge numbers/variety of books. The Cadets are benefitted and utilize their leisure time in studies.































STUDY / RECREATIONAL VISITS

Study/ Recreational visits play an important role in the mental and physical development of a Cadet. Apart from learning it also gives an opportunity to get know-how of multitude of cultures stemming from a great variety of ethnic groups. These visits also help exploring the old-age traditions, variety of food, natural landscapes and above all breathing a fresh air away from the hostel life. All classes get an opportunity to visit different parts of Balochistan however, the senior most class go out for Pakistan Tour for two weeks.

COURSES OFFERED

The College is affiliated with Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education (BISE) Quetta, Baluchistan. Cadets are offered only science subjects both at the Secondary and Higher Secondary Levels (Pre- Medical and Pre- Engineering); no Art stream is offered. Admissions are given in 7th Class only.

MEDICAL FACILITY

Availability of requisite medical facility was a gray area however, in June 19, a Medical Inspection Room (MI Room) along with staff has been established with necessary facilities. One of the available buildings was renovated, equipped with new furniture and desired medicines. Recently, a fully equipped new Ambulance has been given to College. If case of any sickness, Cadet is given proper treatment (First Aid) by a qualified/ competent staff. If desired, the Cadet may be referred to concerned specialists for further treatment however; the expenses for such consultation/ treatments are borne by Parents/ Guardians.

LEAVE

Leave other than the Term Breaks, scheduled/ announced by College, will not be granted except in exceptional circumstances of genuine nature/extreme emergency. No leave will be granted for attending wedding ceremonies except that of real brothers/sisters.

ACCIDENTS AND MISHAPS

The College has adopted all the possible measures for the safety of the Cadets. However, the College shall not be held responsible for any kind of self-caused/ self-inflicted accidents/ mishaps including physical harm or injury while being in the College premises.






EXAMINATIONS

The curriculum is based on the syllabus prescribed by the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Quetta. Cadet College Killa Saifullah conducts following examinations in order to evaluate progress of the Cadets:-

Monthly Tests



Mid Term Exams

At the mid of academic session, the Cadets have to undergo a Mid Term Exam; helpful to observe their progress after a specified period. The Parents are also informed about the progress of their sons/wards by the College accordingly.

Promotion (Annual) Examination (

Promotion/ Annual examinations are held after the completion academic session. Promotion to next class is not automatic; Cadet has to qualify Promotion (Annual) Examination by obtaining minimum 40% marks in each subject to qualify otherwise he is not be promoted to the next class.

Pre-Registration/Send-up Examination (Metric & F. Sc) 😂

Cadets have to pass the examinations specially conducted for the purpose of sending their registration/ admission forms for the Board-Examination. In case of failure, the admission forms are withheld till the time Cadet clears the exams.









CO-CURRICULAR / EXTRA CURRICULAR

Cadet College Killa Saifullah gives emphasis on both academic and physical training of Cadets. Likewise, co-curricular activities are equally essential for overall grooming, discipline and confidence of the Cadets. To develop a healthy sense of competition among the Cadets, InterHouse English and Urdu Debates/ Declamation, General Knowledge, Science Quiz, Spelling Bee, Naat and Qirrat competitions are being organized as scheduled in Annual Calendar.



RIDING CLUB

Riding Club is the favorite place in college for Cadets. They are trained to ride horses and after enough training, the cadets are put into competition into different horse riding events. Cadet College Killa Saifullah have also a Horse Riding Club in the supervision of trained instructors Scout Cadets learn Horse Riding, Show Jumping, High Jump, Trot, Gallop, Tend Pegging and Vaulting. Riding Club provide thrill of outdoor life and develop a spirit of adventure in the Cadets.

Applicants seeking admission are required to pass an Entry Test conducted by a reknown Testing Service. A satisfactory performance in interview, your medical fitness and finally grabbing the top order in the merit list would enable you to be a part of this Premier College. This requires your hard work and concentration towards the goal; if at all you qualify, Cadet College Killa Saifullah will warmly welcome you in the squad of "SAIFIANS".

Admission



Admissions are opened once in a year only in Class 7th, subject to fulfillment of the general conditions.

Announcement (2)



Admissions are announced through the leading English and Urdu: Newspapers & on College web site www.ccks.edu in the month of: November each year.

Candidates are eligible to apply against the seats allocated to their respective District/Province.

Age



Candidates must be over 11 and under 13 years of age on 28 of February in the year of admission for Class 7th. No relaxation of age is permissible.

Qualification



Candidate must have passed Class 6th (Sixth Grade) examination at the time of admission for Class 7th.

Entrance Examination



Selection of a Candidate is made through Written Test, Interview and Medical Examination. Written Test will be conducted through Career Testing Service Pakistan (CTSP) and will be of Class 6th standard for Class 7th.

The following subjects are included in Written Test:-

- → Mathematics ♦ English
- ◆ Urdu **♦** General Science

(Syllabus for Entry Test 🙆

The syllabus for the above 4x mentioned papers will be from Class 6th syllabus of Balochistan Text Book Board. Each paper composition will be Objective - 40% (10x marks) and Subjective - 60% (15x marks).

Selection Procedure (2)



- ♦ Application forms (enclosed with prospectus), complete in all respects, are to be submitted by the last date prescribed in the advertisement published in the print/ electronic media.
- ♦ Written Tests will be held on date announced through advertisement in the print/ electronic media and is intimated individually.
- Date and Venue for Entry Test will be announced later through print electronic media.



- Qualified candidates will be intimated for the scheduled of interview.
- → A merit list will be prepared of all the qualified candidates.
- Final selection will be based on relevant District/ Province/ Minorities and medical examination individually.
- → Final call-up/ Joining letter are then issued (on the day of interview) and the selected Candidates are to join on due date mentioned in Final Self-finance quota.

The College will admit no liability for delay/ no- delivery or loss of the communication due to postal system.

Admission Process - Self Finance Students (2)

Testing Service result is mandatory for applying for self-finance seats; candidates who could not make it on regular merit apply for self-finance. It is added that Self Finance program is only offered/ acceptable to those who have the financial capacity to afford the program; accepted by the parents at the time of admission in the College. Applications are submitted by the desirous applicants after finalization of regular students' selection. The applicants are re-tested through College Test; result of each test is displayed and top 5x candidates are selected for interview; held in the same manner as of regular students.

DUE AND FEE

Total Annual Fee for a Regular Student is **Rs. 75,000/-** and for Self-Finance Student is **Rs. 260,000/-** per annum. The Said Fee has to be paid/ deposited in four equal installments till 1st February, 1st May, 1st August & 1st November of each year. (Each installment for regular student is **Rs. 18750/-** whereas for self finance student is **Rs. 65000/-**) The Cadets have to pay their registration fee for SSC and HSSC examinations as decided by BBISE, Quetta time to time.
